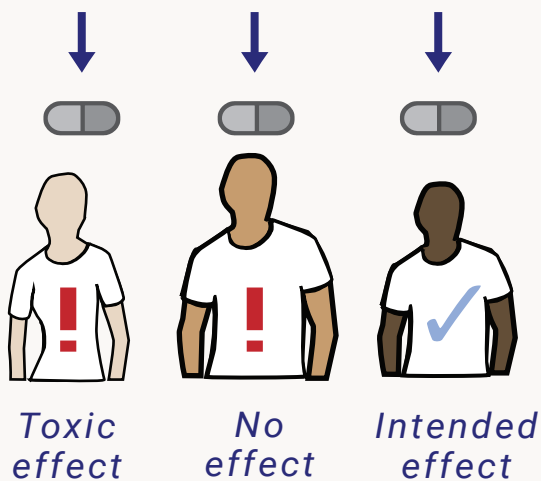

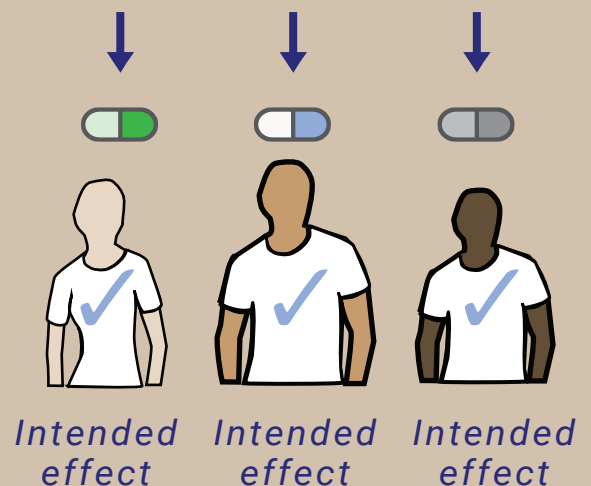

PHARMACIST REVIEWS REPORT

The “Summary Report” is delivered to you and to your doctor and the case pharmacist reaches out to you for a telephone discussion to explain the report

PHARMACIST FOLLOW UP

The pharmacist follows-up with you from time to time to understand if the test results and recommendations were helpful and improved your health condition
